## **Thirst-Aid**

Thirst-Aid will offer two-day Tot Training to all the partners who is working in the humanitarian services, volunteer services, and community based organizations and self-help groups.

## **Objective**

To understand and spread out the knowledge of water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH) for those who work in the humanitarian services, volunteer services, community based organizations and self-help groups.

## **Criteria**

The following criteria are proposed for selection of participants for TOT trainings.

- Must be graduated and at least (high school finished)
- Individuals motivated to improve the water, hygiene, and sanitation situation in their communities

## **Participants**

This Tot training is oriented to the participants who are working in work humanitarian services, volunteer services, communication based organizations and self-help groups.

Only **twenty participants** will be selected for the training and according to Gender balance 10 women and men will be selected. (Exception: participation by women can be more encouraged)

## **Language**

The training will be conducted in both Myanmar and English.
